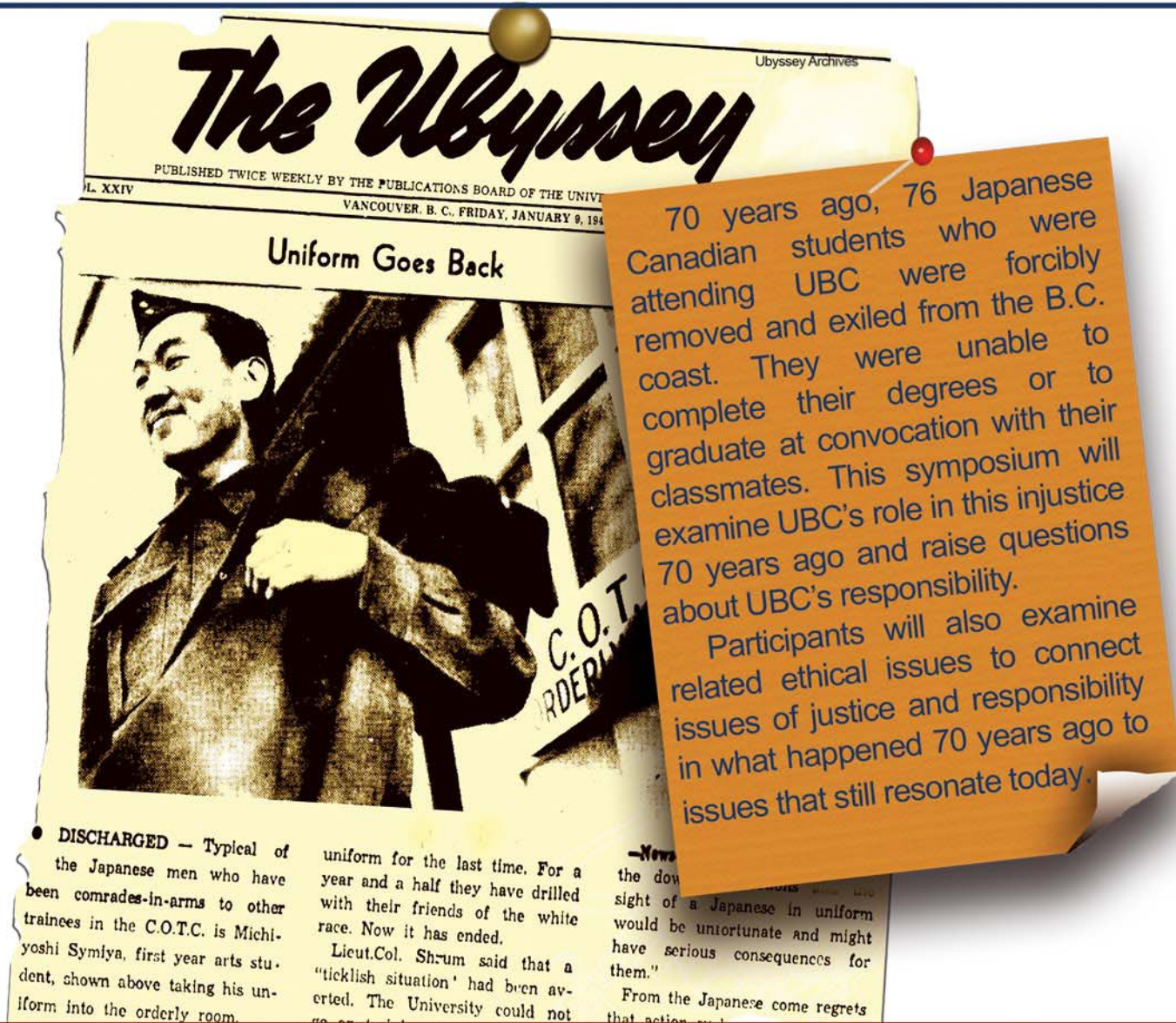


Addressing Injustice: UBC's Response to the Internment of Japanese Canadian Students - Then and Now
